

How SST Works

- ✍ Principal, teacher, or parent refers student to SST.
- ✍ Assessments of student's academics, behavior, and life skills are obtained.
- ✍ SST and parents brainstorm strategies to help the student achieve success in the classroom.
- ✍ Classroom teachers choose the strategies that she/he feels comfortable using and will be most successful for the child.
- ✍ Strategies are implemented in the classroom, documented, and reported.
- ✍ After 5 to 6 weeks, a follow-up discussion of the student's progress is scheduled.
